

Title Reference: Consideration of the community right to bid (assets of community value) nomination for the Rose Hill United Reformed Church	
Key Decision: No	Delegation Reference: HW000
Report and Background papers	Public
Record of Decision: Resolved – That Chesterfield Borough Council does not list Rose Hill United Reformed Church, Soresby Street as an asset of community value.	
Reasons for Decision: Rose Hill United Reformed Church, Soresby Street is not considered to meet the asset of community value criteria.	
Alternative options considered and rejected (if any) To list Rose Hill United Reformed Church as a partial asset listing. The assessment, however, has confirmed that the Rose Hill United Reformed Church does not meet the criteria within the Localism legislation, and as such, should not be listed as an Asset of Community Value.	

Notes:

The implementation of the above decision is suspended until the call-in period has expired without a call-in being validly invoked. Any Member of the Council shall be entitled to call for a decision to be suspended by giving notice to the Monitoring Officer *either by telephone, fax, email or in writing* not later than 5.00 pm on the day following the date of the decision.
