RESOLVED -

- 1.1 That the Cabinet Member accepts that the subject areas of land are surplus to the Council's requirements and approves sales at the negotiated sums referred to in the main body of the report.
- 1.2 To authorise the Service Director Economic Growth to agree any further amendments to the sale transactions.

Reasons for Decision:

- 2.1 The proposed sales will realise modest receipts together with payment of the Council's professional fees. The receipts will be credited to the General Fund and General Fund Revenue accounts.
- 2.2 The sale of one of the areas of land will alleviate the Council of the liabilities associated with the presence of Japanese knotweed and will also assist the Coal Authority in its statutory functions to prevent mine water pollution to rivers, streams, and groundwater aguifers.

Alternative options considered and rejected (if any)

It is not judged that there is a plausible alternative option to be pursued other than to do nothing.
