The tree has lifted on the root plate and is hanging on a neighbouring tree.	Consent is granted to the felling of one Lime tree. A nearby young Cherry tree is accepted as a replacement on this occasion and shall be maintained under the terms of the preservation order.
CHE/18/00199/TPO TPO 4901.189 16/05/18	The pruning of two Ash trees reference T10 & T11 on the Order map for Mr Rayner of 6 Glenavon Close, New Whittington. The trees are allegedly causing light issues and overhanging the neighbours property.	Consent is refused to the removal of all branches growing over the neighbouring properties because this would leave the canopy unbalanced and reduce the trees amenity value. The trees already have a high canopy and are at a reasonable distance from the neighbouring properties. Consent is granted to a light crown thin which includes the removal of dead branches in the crown.
CHE/18/00219/TPO TPO 4901.117 17/05/18	The pruning of 7 Sycamore trees reference G1 on the Order map for Mr Cook of 146 Hady Hill. The trees are overhanging the property from the grounds of St Peter St Paul School, Hady Hill	Consent is granted to the crown lifting of 3 trees and the reduction of branches of 4 trees growing towards the property pruning back to the boundary line and pruning back to suitable replacement branches.

<p>CHE/18/00231/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.43</p> <p>18/05/18</p>	<p>The pruning of 4 Lime trees reference T5-T7 & T12 on the Order map for Westside Landscapes at 3 The Willows, Somersall Lane, Somersall.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the crown clean and crown lift of T5-T7 and a crown reduction of 60% to T6 to remove the dead and weak upper growth to create a high pollard.</p> <p>Consent is also granted to the pruning of T12 Lime to reduce branches growing to the south by 1.5 metres to re-balance the crown and crown clean to remove dead branches and epicormics growth.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00232/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.174</p> <p>21/05/18</p>	<p>The pruning of 1 Ash tree reference T19 on the Order map for Westside Landscapes to the rear of 61 Foxbrook Drive, Walton.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the re-pollarding of one Ash tree pruning back to previous pollarding points.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00324/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.329</p> <p>31/05/18</p>	<p>The pruning of 1 Ash tree reference T1 on the Order map for Mr Revill of 46 Blackthorn Close, Hasland.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the crown reduction of the tree by 25% pruning back to previous reduction points, a crown lift by 4.5 metres from ground level and a crown clean to remove dead wood.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00294/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.315</p> <p>05/06/18</p>	<p>The pruning of 3 trees within G1 on the Order map consisting of 1 Ash, 1 Lime and 1 Sycamore at the former Ringwood Centre, Brimington.</p>	<p>Consent is refused to the removal of 3 lower branches of the Sycamore because this would in affect side up the tree making the crown one sided. The outer crown of the trees canopy is approximately 3 metres from the new dwelling which is an acceptable distance from the property.</p>

		<p>Consent is granted to the removal of one damaged branch on the Ash tree and the crown lifting by 3 metres of the Lime and Sycamore trees.</p> <p>A further application has been invited from the applicant to crown lift and crown thin all the trees within the group to alleviate the alleged light issues.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00366/TPO TPO 4901.159 07/06/18</p>	<p>The felling of one Sycamore tree reference T21 on the Order map for The Derby of Diocesan Board of Finance Ltd at 674 Chatsworth Road.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the felling of one Sycamore tree which has decay and Ganoderma fungal brackets at the base of the tree which makes the stem and roots brittle and prone to failure.</p> <p>A condition has been attached for a replacement Oak to be planted in the next available planting season.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00248/TPO TPO 4901.281 07/06/18</p>	<p>The pruning of two Ash trees and the removal of one horizontal growing stem within G1 on the Order map for Trueman Tree Services at 59 Pomegranate Road, Pomegranate Park, Newbold.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the removal of one horizontal stem pruning back to the main tree and the crown lifting of one Ash by 3 metres from ground level and the reduction of branches on one Ash growing towards the street light to give a 1 metre clearance.</p>

<p>CHE/18/00268/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.12</p> <p>08/06/18</p>	<p>The pruning of two Oak trees reference T23 & T24 on the Order map for Mark Whatley Tree Services on behalf of Mrs Morris of 1 Ash Vale. The trees are located at 386 Old Road and overhang into the neighbouring property.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the crown lifting of two Oaks by 4 metres and the crown thinning by 20% to allow more light into the neighbouring property.</p>
<p>CHE/18/00333/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.292</p> <p>11/06/18</p>	<p>The pruning of one Cedar tree reference T1 on the Order map for Treefellas Arboriculture Ltd on behalf of Mrs Osbiston of 7 Netherleigh Road.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the crown lifting of one Cedar tree by 4.5 metres and crown thin by 20% to allow more light into the garden. Consent is refused to the reduction of branches growing over the neighbouring property because this would lose the trees natural shape and reduce its amenity value. The approved works should also remove the need to reduce the branches.</p>
