 - Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23:00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08:00 and 23:00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
 - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23:00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08:00 and 23:00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports -- defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts -- are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08:00 and 23:00 on any day, on any premises.

ANNEX 2 – CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING

General - All Four Licensing Objectives

Brampton Manor is primarily a food and drink led establishment with the capacity to host indoor and outdoor events.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

An incident book will be kept at the premises in which will be recorded all incidents of crime and disorder. This book will be reviewed by the manager and area manager. It will be retained on the premises for a period of 3 years and made available on request to an Officer of a Responsible Authority.

CCTV is installed at the venue covering the external areas of the premises and the rear of the bar. Images will be retained for a period of 28 days and will be made available on request to an Officer of a Responsible Authority.

SIA licensed door supervisors will be deployed on the premises on a risk assessed basis. Risk assessments will be retained on the premises for a period of 3 years and made available on request to an Officer of a Responsible Authority.

Staff will be given basic drug awareness training as part of their induction when commencing employment.

Where alcohol is sold for consumption in outside areas of the venue, the use of polycarbonate or plastic glassware will be considered by way of a risk assessment. Bottles of alcohol will be decanted into pitchers. Such risk assessments will be retained on the premises for a period of 3 years and made available on request to an Officer of a Responsible Authority.

Public Safety

Implement staff induction and refresher training on statutory requirements such as fire, evacuation and Health and Safety.

Relevant Health & Safety Legislation, Fire and other primary legislation will be complied with.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Clear notices/signs will be displayed near the entrance/exit doors of the building at site entrances/exits reminding patrons to respect local residents and to leave the venue quietly.

During periods of regulated entertainment doors and windows of the building will be closed at 23:00 hours.

For any outdoor events the following bodies will be given 28 days' notice of the date, time and duration of the event:

- Derbyshire Police Licensing Department
- Local Authority Environmental Health and Licensing Departments.

The venue is subject to a noise management plan which will only be amended after consultation with the Local Authority Environmental Health Department.

Protection of Children from Harm

All training is provided on commencement of employment on the law relating to all age restricted products sold and any system or procedures in place which employees are expected to follow.

Refresher training should be provided at regular intervals (at least six monthly).

Records detailing the training provided will be kept for a minimum of two years (either on the premises or at Head Office) and made available on request to an Officer of a Responsible Authority.

A Challenge 25 Scheme will be operated at the premises. Acceptable forms of identification will be PASS accredited proof of age card, photo driving licence or passport. Failure to produce satisfactory proof of age will result in a refused sale.

Clear prominent signage informing customers of the scheme will be displayed in the premises.

A refusal log will be maintained in the premises which the Designated Premises Supervisor (or Deputy authorised in writing) will, at least weekly, examine the record and action as necessary. The records will be retained for a minimum of two years (either on the premises or at Head Office) and made available to an Officer of a Responsible Authority on request.
