CHE/23/00290/TPO TPO 4901.261 26/06/23	The pruning of 5 trees reference T2, T5-T8 Lime on the Order Map and which are situated along the driveway of Hunters Walk, Saltergate.	<p>Consent is refused to the lopping of the tops (height) and side branches of 5 Lime trees. The lopping of branches to such a degree would make the trees unsightly, unbalanced and instigate epicormic growth on the lopped branch framework which would in turn create a denser canopy.</p> <p>The trees are approximately 23 metres away from the main dwellings with a branch spread of approximately 5-6 metres outwards from the main stem located along Hunters Walk which is at a suitable distance from the main dwellings along Tennyson Avenue.</p> <p>Consent is granted to the crown lifting of the trees to 5.2 metres to allow light underneath the canopy and to selectively prune branches growing towards 11 Tennyson Avenue to re-shape the crown and to some degree remove some overhanging branches</p>

		to the garden area.

A condition has been attached to plant one Maple tree in the next available planting season.

Consent is granted to crown lift, crown thin and reduce branches growing towards the property to give a 2 metre clearance from the structure.

<p>CHE/23/00367/TPO TPO 4901.153 10/07/23</p>	<p>The pruning of 8 Oak trees and mixed hedgerow species consisting of Hazel, Hawthorn and Holly within G1 on the Order Map and which are situated to the east of 4 Ballidon Close, Newbold</p>	<p>Consent is granted to crown lift the trees 6 Oak trees to 4.5 metres and 5.2 metres over the highway. Crown thin by a maximum of 20% and the reduction of side branches by 2-3 metres pruning back to suitable replacement branches and clearing the property structure.</p> <p>Consent is also granted to a 50% crown reduction of the hedgerow consisting of Hazel, Holy and Hawthorn to leave a 2 metre high hedge but retaining its natural appearance.</p>

The duty to replant has been dispensed with on this occasion due to insufficient room and no loss of amenity to the group.</p> <p>Consent is also granted to crown clean the</p>

		remaining Scots Pine and Larch trees to remove dead wood and storm damaged branches.
CHE/23/00358/TPO TPO 4901.174 10/07/23	The pruning of one Oak tree reference T5 on the Order Map and which is situated in the rear garden of 7 Sandstone Avenue, Walton.	Consent is granted to the crown reduction of one Oak tree by a maximum of 2-3 metres to re-shape the tree and clear structures. Crown lift by 4 metres and remove dead wood within the crown.
CHE/23/00378/TPO TPO 4901.160 12/07/23	The pruning of one Oak tree reference T71 on the Order map at Hasland Support Centre, 86 The Green, Hasland.	Consent is granted to crown lift the Oak tree by 5.2 metres to facilitate the delivery of temporary classroom units to the site.
