No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below

- Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits
 requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and
 area quietly.
- 2. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
- 3. Patrons will be asked to leave quietly, and notices will be displayed to this effect.
- 4. The premises will encourage the use of the front lobby entrance during live regulated entertainment.
- 5. Doors and windows will be inspected during live regulated entertainment to ensure that they are kept closed.

Protection of Children from Harm

The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply. No unusual or additional risks of harm to children have been identified.

No films or videos of any description will be shown so that they can be viewed by persons under the age of any applicable BBFC/Local Authority certification.

Children under the age of 16 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 21:00.

ANNEX 3 - CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

At a hearing on 7th June 2011 the Licensing Committee decided to take the following action:-

- (1) to remove Elizabeth Anne Lowe as the Designated Premises Supervisor;
- (2) to suspend the licence for a period of 3 months;
- (3) to modify the conditions of the licence as follows:-
- (a) Subject to (b) below, no licensable activities shall be carried out at the premises whilst Elizabeth Anne Lowe is in occupation of the premises;
- (b) Subject to (a) above, no licensable activities shall be carried out at the premises until the works and steps required by Health and Safety to be carried out as identified in their report dated 23rd May 2011 have been completed to their satisfaction; and
- (c) no children under the age of 18 shall be allowed on the premises after 9.00 pm.


