		A degree of seasonal inconvenience and additional maintenance associated with the shedding of leaves, small twigs and other debris is an unavoidable consequence of owning a property containing protected trees. It is considered that the overall impact in this instance is not too excessive and not a sufficient reason to warrant a heavy reduction of the crown.
