

**Performance Report – November 2014**

Recorded crime figures are based on the current Home Office Crime Groupings. From April 2014, crime is classified by the Home Office as either Victim Based or Crimes against society

Victim Based - Violence with injury, violence without injury, sexual offences, business robbery, personal robbery, domestic burglary, non-domestic burglary, theft of vehicle, theft from vehicle, interfere with vehicle, bicycle theft, shoplifting, all other theft offences and criminal damage and arson.

Crimes against society - Drug offences, possession of weapons offences, public order offences and miscellaneous crimes against society.

A copy of the new crime tree from April 2014 can be seen on Page 2.

As of 2013, the majority of Fraud offences are recorded nationally by Action Fraud. Those recorded by the police are mainly 'making off without payment' offences which are now recorded under 'other stealing'. Therefore, 'Fraud and Forgery' offences are excluded from this report.

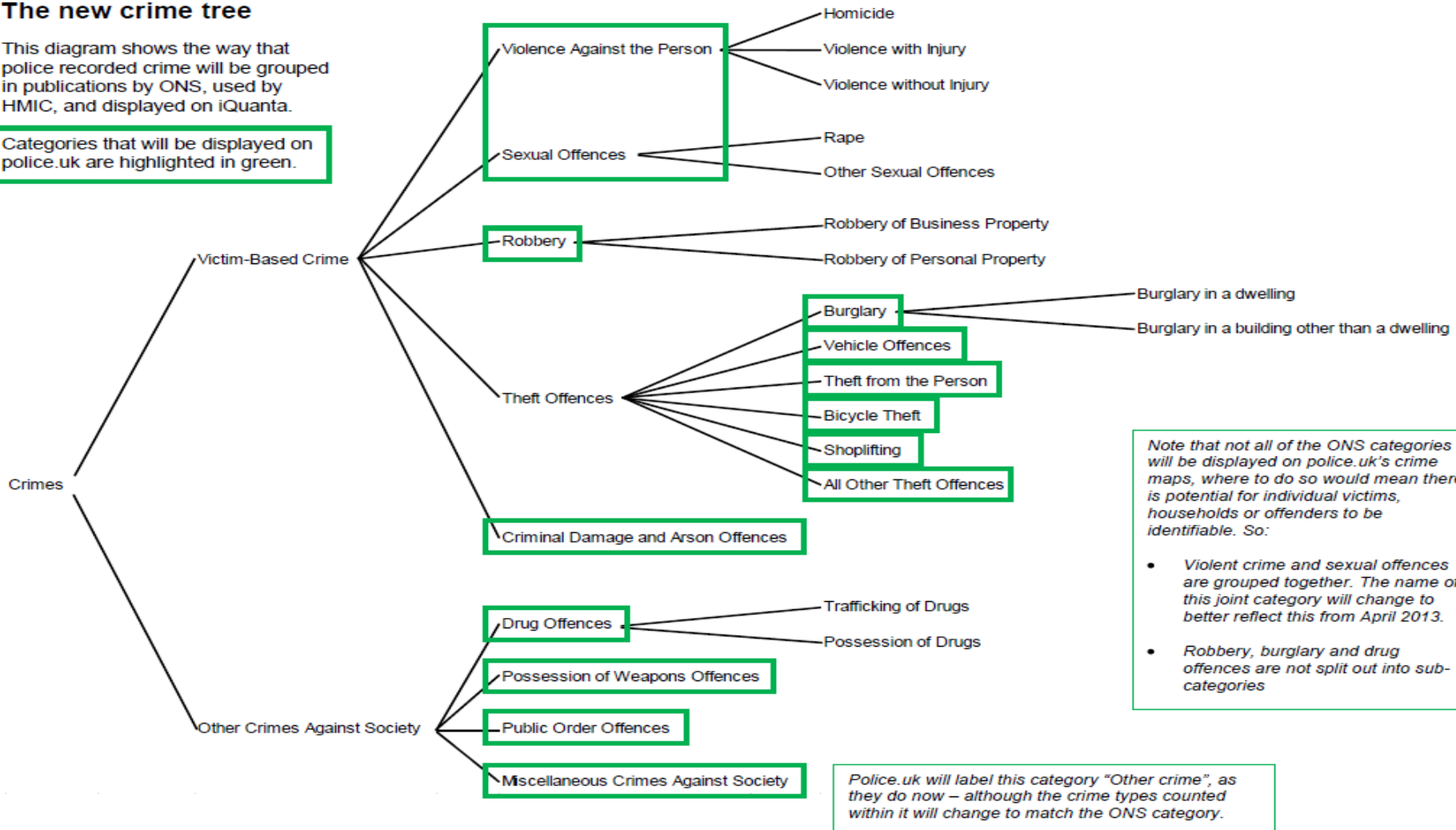
Crime and Incident Data are based on the recorded date of the crime / incident and reflects the data as at the point the data is taken from live Guardian and Command and Control systems. It is therefore subject to change.

Data is provided for the Administrative County and each Council Area for Derbyshire (including Derby City). Comparisons are made for the latest full 12 month periods with the previous 12 months. Year to date / historical levels will be mentioned where appropriate with specific figures provided (Full Year to Date and previous monthly figure data tables are available on request). A green highlight indicates a reduction in crime/ incidents, with a red highlight

**The new crime tree**

This diagram shows the way that police recorded crime will be grouped in publications by ONS, used by HMIC, and displayed on iQuanta.

Categories that will be displayed on police.uk are highlighted in green.



Note that not all of the ONS categories will be displayed on police.uk's crime maps, where to do so would mean there is potential for individual victims, households or offenders to be identifiable. So:

- Violent crime and sexual offences are grouped together. The name of this joint category will change to better reflect this from April 2013.
- Robbery, burglary and drug offences are not split out into sub-categories

Police.uk will label this category "Other crime", as they do now – although the crime types counted within it will change to match the ONS category.

**Comment.**

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in the Admin County has seen a 2.5% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months.

Violence with injury, Shoplifting, Vehicle interference and Drug offences have seen the largest increases during this period.

The largest reductions have been in Non domestic burglary, Criminal damage, Other Theft offences and Theft from vehicle.

**November 2014** – All crime (2552) is below the past 12 months average (2684). Burglary dwelling (141) was the highest count since March 2014. Theft from vehicle (171) was the lowest count since February 2013. Bicycle theft (20) had the lowest count since April 2014 and Other theft offences (318) the lowest count since February 2014. Non domestic burglary (195) is well below the past 12 months average (231).

**Year to Date figures – Compares April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (-853) has decreased by 3.7%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+418), Vehicle interference (+105) and Sexual offences (+95). The largest decreases are in Non domestic burglary (-444), Criminal damage (-293), Theft from vehicle (-284), Other theft offences (-212) and Domestic burglary (-113).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen a 6.5% reduction (-2055) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there have been 827 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

### Comment.

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in Amber Valley has seen 4.6% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months.

Violence with injury and Shoplifting have seen the largest increases during this period.

Non domestic burglary, Domestic Burglary, Other theft offences and Violence without injury have seen the largest decreases.

**November 2014** – All crime (469) is above the past 12 months average (429). Criminal damage (116) was the highest count in the past 2 years, Burglary dwelling (33) the highest count since October 2013 and Shoplifting (61) the highest count in the past 6 months. All remaining crime types remain close to their past 12 months average.

**Year to Date figures – April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (-150) has decreased by 4.1%. The largest increase is in Violence with injury (+82). The largest decreases are in Non domestic burglary (-209) and Domestic burglary (-62).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen a 5.6% decrease (-282) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there has been 138 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

### Comment.

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in Bolsover has seen a 6.1% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months.

Shoplifting, Criminal damage and violence with injury have seen the largest increases during this period.

The largest reductions are in Other theft offences and Non domestic burglary.

**November 2014** – All crime (265) is slightly below the past 12 months average (284). Domestic burglary (21) remains slightly above the past 12 months average (15). Other theft offences (26) was the lowest count in the last 2 years and Shoplifting (17) was the lowest count in the past 6 months. All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

**Year to Date figures – April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (-159) has decreased by 6.5%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+39) and Violence without injury (+26). The largest decreases are in Other theft offences (-127), Non domestic burglary (-89) and Theft from vehicle (-56).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen a 0.1% increase (+5) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there have been 146 more calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

### Comment.

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in Chesterfield has seen a 2.1% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months.

Drug offences, Shoplifting and Violence with injury have seen the largest increases during this period.

The largest reductions are in Criminal damage, Other theft offences, Theft from vehicle and Theft from the person.

**November 2014** – All crime (487) is slightly below the past 12 months average (505). Domestic burglary (30) was the highest count since August 2013 whilst Violence without injury (48) was slightly above the past 12 months average (37). Both Non domestic burglary (13) and Other theft offences (43) had their lowest counts in the past 2 years.

**Year to Date figures – April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (-283) has decreased by 6.5%. The largest increases are in Drug offence (+70) and Violence with injury (+46). The largest decreases are in Criminal damage (-124), Theft from vehicle (-89) and Other theft offences (-84).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen a 3% reduction (-179) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there have been 168 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

**Comment.**

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in Derbyshire Dales has seen a 5.3% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months.

Violence with injury has seen the largest increase during this period.

The largest reductions have been in Other theft offences, Non domestic burglary and Shoplifting.

**November 2014** – All crime (169) is below the past 12 months average (178). Shoplifting (6) had the lowest count since December 2013 whilst Theft from vehicle (6) and Other theft offences (22) remain below their respective past 12 months average (10 and 27). All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

**Year to Date figures – April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (-144) has decreased by 8.8%. The largest increase is in Violence with injury (+37). The largest decreases are in Other theft offences (-83) and Non domestic burglary (-56).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen an 8.7% reduction (-148) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there have been 24 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

**Comment.**

**Rolling 12 months figures** - Crime in Erewash has seen a 2% increase when compared with the previous 12 months.

Violence with injury, Shoplifting and Vehicle interference have seen the largest increases during this period.

The largest reductions have been in Criminal damage, Domestic burglary and Non domestic burglary.

**November 2014** – All crime (419) is well below the past 12 months average (503). Domestic burglary (18), Theft of vehicle (6) and Theft from vehicle (22) all had their lowest counts in the past 2 years. Violence without injury (27) was the lowest count since January 2014. Bicycle theft (6), Shoplifting (54) and Criminal damage (65) were all below their respective past 12 months average (12, 65 and 76).

**Year to Date figures – April to November 2013 and 2014.** All crime (+69) has increased by 1.7%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+159), Other theft offences (+41) and Vehicle interference (+40). The largest decreases are in Criminal damage (-77), Non domestic burglary (-62) and Domestic burglary (-61).

**ASB** (see Appendices 1 and 2) - Calls for Service have seen a 2.6% reduction (-124) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April to November) there have been 7 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.
