**The Prevention of Crime and Disorder**

The above property is situated opposite a children's playground and recreation park. There is a licenced public house further to the north (25m approximately) which caters well for the neighbourhood and given that alcohol may only be served and consumed on the premises this controls the underage and unsociable abuse of alcohol which I fear an off licence will not.

There is also an existing off licence situated approx 100m to the south(photo attached) which caters well for the small villages needs

I attach documents relating to public vandalism that the park did suffer in the past. This antisocial behaviour often fueled by underage drinking and substance abuse resulted in the demolition of a public building to control this problem Having a second off licence situated within 100m of each other will only cause extra problems within an already fragile neighbourhood.

Further to this point there is a nursing home which is residence to some of our more challenging charges. It is up to us as a society to protect these individuals so that they cannot harm themselves or other people however due to the nature of their problems and circumstances, many are over the legal consent age and so can purchase alcohol freely. I do feel that an extra establishment selling alcohol will only cause problems for our public and police force.

**Public Safety**

The road which the property is situated is one of the main arteries to the Royal Hospital and given the nature of the road it did turn into something of a race track. This was address with the addition of speed bumps between the shops location and the junction to Grove Road (attached photos) and double yellow lines marked on the attached map. Having an extra off licence to open on this road will only have problems with on street parking to gain access to the business.

There is a bus stop located opposite the premises which will lead to the road being blocked by parked vehicles(please see attached ariel photo),with being a resident for over 40yrs I can speak from experience as this has lead in the past to a number of accidents and ambulances unable to overtake,this problem has been tamed while the old post office has been closed but a change of licence on this building will only lead to increased traffic and unsafe on road parking(please see attached photo), Access to the property can be a problem as There is no pedestrian crossing to protect the public who will be crossing Manor Road at the location and With this being the crossing for the trans Pennine trail can only see the resulting traffic leading to a road traffic accident (please see attached form)

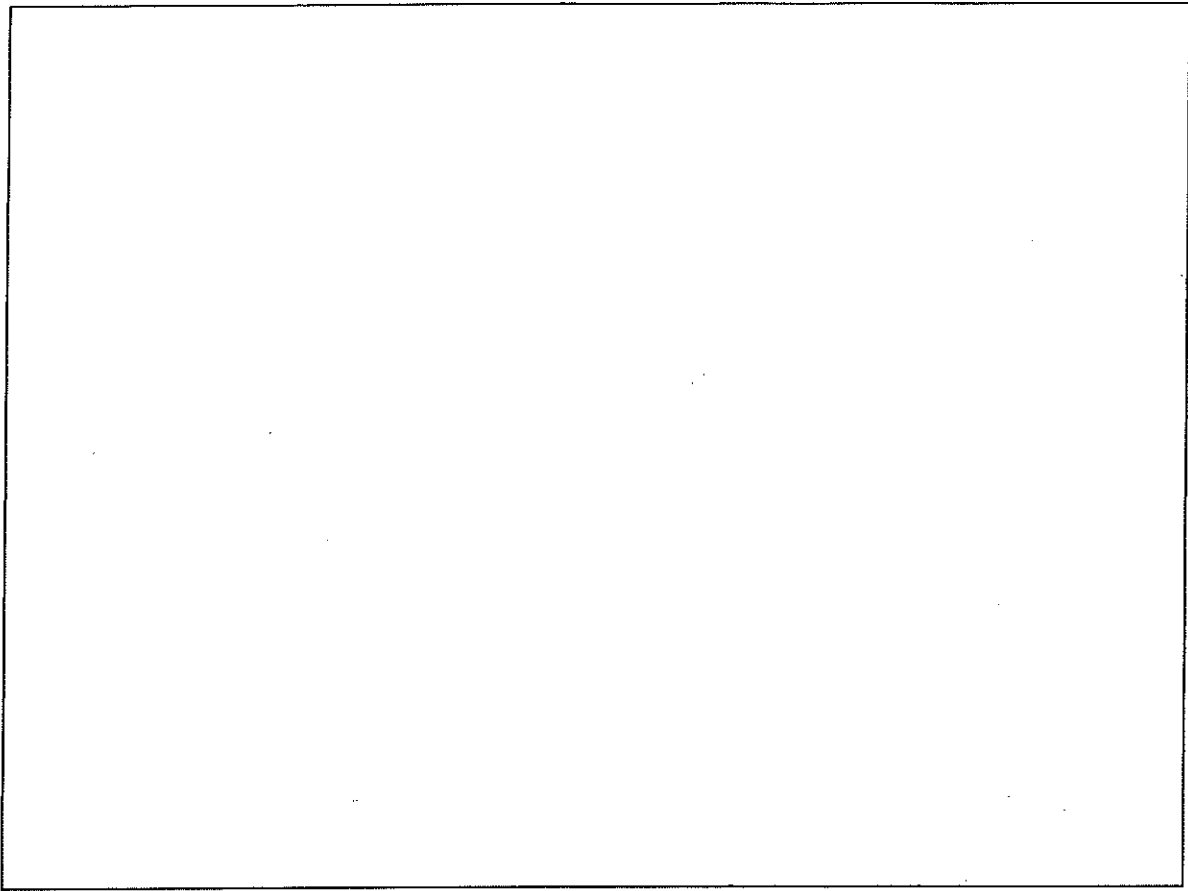


