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### **1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is for the Committee to determine an application for a Review of the premises licence in respect of Pizza Royal, 1 Holywell Street, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S41 7SA.

### **2.0 APPLICATION**

- 2.1 The application for a review was submitted by Sgt 3402 Winterbottom of Derbyshire Police, on the 13 November 2019. A copy of the application form is attached at Appendix 1.
- 2.2 The application for review is in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety licensing objectives.

### 3.0 **BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 The premises licence for Pizza Royal was originally granted on 29 September 2007 and is licensed for the following;

Late night refreshment (Indoors) Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 4pm to 1am, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 4pm to 4am and Sunday from 4pm to 3am.

- 3.2 The current premises licence holder is Hamid Reza Jaber. Mr Hamid Reza Jaber became the premise license holder on 10 May 2016.

- 3.3 A copy of the premises licence is attached at Appendix 2.

### 4.0 **APPLICATION FOR REVIEW**

- 4.1 The grounds for the review are following a disturbance that took place in the premises at 03:30am on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 where a male has received a broken arm by an unknown offender in an unprovoked attack.

- 4.2 Crucial to the investigation is the CCTV, however enquiries by officers at the premises on the night and in subsequent days established that no staff member present on the night or there after knew how to operate the system.

- 4.3 At Annex 3 – Conditions Attached After A Hearing By The Licensing Authority of the Premise License it states:

1. To install and maintain a closed circuit television system to a standard required by Police Licensing.

This system will be operational and recording during any time when the premises are open for licensable activities as specified within the premise license. The system will cover the inside and immediately outside the premises. This system will keep all recorded images for a period of no less than twenty eight days. There must be a person trained in the use of the system either at the premises or available to retrieve any

recorded images or data immediately upon request of a police officer or authorised person acting on behalf of a responsible authority as detailed within Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 4.4 Officers eventually accessed the system 8 days later to find that the system only retained images for 7 days, all possible images had been written over. Key witness evidence had been lost.

## 5.0 **REPRESENTATIONS**

- 5.1 When an application for a review is submitted, the Licensing Authority is required to put a notice of the application on display at the premises to which it relates and at the offices of the Licensing Authority. These steps were carried out on the 14 November 2019 in accordance with the Licensing Act and the relevant regulations.

- 5.2 The premises licence holder, responsible authorities and interested parties have the opportunity of making representations within a period of 28 days starting from the day after the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority. Representations must be relevant to one or more of the four licensing objectives. The deadline for representations was 11 December 2019.

- 5.3 No further objections have been received from any of the Responsible Authorities.

## 6.0 **OPTIONS**

- 6.1 When carrying out its licensing functions, the Licensing Authority must do so with a view to promoting the 4 licensing objectives and also with regard to its Statement of Licensing Policy and the guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.

- 6.2 The Licensing Committee may decide;

- to modify the conditions of the licence
- to exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
- to remove the designated premises supervisor
- to suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
- to revoke the licence

6.3 Where either the applicant or a person who made relevant representations is aggrieved by the decision of the Licensing Authority, appeal is to the Magistrates' Court.

## 7.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

7.1 That the Licensing Committee consider the application for review and what action to take as set out in paragraph 6.2 of this report.

**Officers have eventually accessed the system 8 days later to find that the system only retained images for 7 days, all possible images had been written over. Key witness evidence has been lost.**

**Mr Hamid Reza Jaberi became the current Premises Licence Holder on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2016, as such as holder of the licence Mr Jaberi should be aware and enforce all conditions upon his licence.**

It is the view of the Chief Officer of Police that the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety licensing objectives have been undermined in this matter.

Derbyshire Constabulary cannot satisfy themselves that Premises Licence Holder is able to show due regard to the above two licensing conditions. ### ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The following text is from the Operating Schedule:-

#### General

At the premises the staff will have a monthly training programme in order to keep the health, hygiene and safety up to date and will have a daily routine to follow in order to comply with safety.

They will have a uniform.

Variation:-

There are 4 CCTV cameras, two inside and two outside the premises. They are waterproof and damage proof and record up to three months.

The shop has two doors which ensure a continuous flow of customers, thereby alleviating any allegations of queue jumping thus preventing any disorder.

Being a member of the Community of Corporation Street, they meet once a month to discuss any issues to improve the service to the public ensuring their comfort and safety.

As being the owner for a long time, he has gained a lot of respect from customers and other business people in the area. The owner has experience of handling members of the public when they are intoxicated resulting in a positive outcome without the necessity for calling for assistance.

During Bank Holidays or busy periods the owner will employ a doorman/security man to prevent any disruption within the vicinity.

Customers tend to be adults but if children come into the premises the owner would ensure safety of children at all time. The presence of cameras both inside and outside the building would record any incidents, should they arise concerning any child in the vicinity.

#### The Premises

Anybody whom is seen drunk or in a bad state will be refused by the staff at the counter.

We will be involved with other authorities in order to keep the crime and disorder well away from the premises.
