That the Assistant Director – Customers, Commissioning and Change, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Business Transformation and Customers and interim Chief Finance Officer, be granted delegated authority to complete regular reviews of the scheme, ensuring grant funds are fully utilised for the benefit of local businesses. 3. That the decisions be treated as urgent and exempt from call-in, in accordance with paragraphs 12.2 and 14.15 of the Scrutiny Procedure Rules in Part 4 of the Constitution.	
Reasons for Decision: To enable Chesterfield Borough Council to proceed with the administration of its Local Authority Discretionary Grant Fund scheme, to the benefit of local businesses and the local economy. Under Section 15 (4) of the Local Government Act 2000 where the discharge of a function has not been allocated in the scheme of delegation by the Council (in approving these executive arrangements), the Leader may individually discharge that function themselves, subject to this discharge being reported to full Council.
