Record of Decision taken by Cabinet - 14 September, 2021

At a meeting of the Cabinet held on 14 September, 2021, the following decisions were reached on the items listed in the attached schedule.

The implementation of these Cabinet decisions is suspended until the call-in period has expired without a call-in being validly invoked.
