## \*RESOLVED -

- 1. That the revised sale price for the subject land, on the terms set out in the officer's report, be approved.
- 2. That the Property, Procurement and Contracts Law Manager be granted delegated authority to agree any late amendments to the sale.

Reasons for Decision:

- 1. To reduce the Council's maintenance liabilities associated with holding the land and to realise a modest capital receipt.
- 2. The land has no real potential to generate income for the Council and is too small to have any value for redevelopment independent of adjoining property.
- 3. A sale to the owner of 109 Chesterfield Road is therefore considered to be the best option in the circumstances to realise value from the asset.
