# 1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 To enable determination of the application for a new premises license in respect of

2 Foljambe Road

Chesterfield

Derbyshire

S40 1NW

- 1.2 Relevant representations have been made in respect of the application and not withdrawn. Consequently, the application cannot be granted or refused under officer delegated authority.

- 2.2 Copies of the Application Form and premises plan are attached to this report at Appendix 1 and 2.
- 3.0 Report Details
- 3.1 The premises was previously a Dental Laboratory.
- 3.2 The premises is situated on a primarily residential road however there are some other business in the immediate surrounding area, including Mecca Bingo, the Salvation Army Shop and KFC.
- 3.3 The photograph below shows the location.



# 4.0 **Application**

- 4.1 The application was received on 02 February 2023 to license the premises as an off-license.
- 4.2 The applicant describes the premises as "convenient store selling alcohol, tobacco, chilled food, lottery and paypoint services"

- 4.3 The initial application seeks the sale and supply of alcohol (off premises) Monday to Saturday between 6am 10pm and Sundays between 8am 8pm. The opening hours proposed are Monday to Saturday 6am 10pm and Sundays 8am 8pm.
- 4.4 No representations have been received from the Responsible Authorities. Derbyshire Police did raise concern over existing antisocial behaviour and street drinking in the vicinity and have made an agreement with the applicant that they would be happy with alcohol sales, off premises, Monday to Saturday between 7am 9pm and Sundays 8am 8pm. Appendix 3
- 4.5 Applications for a new Premises License are required to be advertised by way of an advert in the local press, a site notice displayed at the premises, inclusion on the Local Authority's web page and copies of the application submitted to all Responsible Authorities.
- 4.6 The appropriate local press public notice appeared in the Derbyshire Times newspaper on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2023.
- 4.7 The site notice displayed on the premises, advertising the application was viewed by licensing enforcement staff on 09<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The notice had been displayed behind frosted glass so the applicant was advised to move the notice so it could be more easily read.
- 4.8 The notice was rechecked on 24 February 2023 and found to be correct.
- 4.9 The details of the application were posted on Chesterfield Borough Council's Licensing Department web page.
- 4.10 The application was distributed to the Responsible Authorities.
- 4.11 The statutory deadline for representation was 02 March 2023. Responsible Authorities and Interested Parties are entitled to make representations to the License Authority provided they are relevant.
- 4.12 Ten representations have been received from local residents.
- 4.13 The representations relate to one or more of the licensing objectives which are:
  - The prevention of crime and disorder
  - Public safety
  - The prevention of public nuisance

- Protection of children from harm
- 4.14 The representation forms can be seen in full at Appendices 4 to 13.
- 4.15 The representations express concerns over:
  - Increased anti-social behaviour, street drinking, rough sleeping, and drug dealing/taking in an area already experiencing these issues
  - Bringing further traffic to an already busy road
  - Parking issues
  - Noise nuisance to residential neighbours
  - Increased amounts of litter
  - Concerns over the close proximity of the proposed shop to the Fairplay Centre where vulnerable children and adults go.
- 4.16 As part of the application process the applicant is required to describe in the operating schedule the additional steps that are intended to be taken in order to promote the licensing objectives for the new premises license that has been requested.
- 4.17 Under the Licensing Act 2003 these volunteered proposed steps will be attached to the premises license as conditions which must be complied with. These are set out in Part M of the application form.

#### 5.0 Conclusion

- 5.1 When carrying out its licensing functions, the Licensing Authority must do so with a view to promoting the four licensing objectives and also with regard to its Statement of Licensing Policy and the guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 5.2 Where either the applicant or a person who makes relevant representations is aggrieved by the decision of the Licensing Authority, appeal is to the Magistrates' Court.
- 5.3 As relevant representations have been made in respect of the application and not withdrawn, the application cannot be granted or refused under officer delegated authority.
- 5.4 The Licensing Committee is therefore asked to consider the application and determine it by

- Granting it subject to condition/modification
- Or Refusing the application.

Madam / Sir

I would like to raise an objection to the above application for a licence to sell alcohol on the basis that:

- 1. The location of the Salvation Army premises next door already encourages people to loiter, and it is not unusual to see people under the influence of drugs or drink hanging around the car park and walking along Foljambe Road. The sale of alcohol at this address will serve to encourage some people to hang around after making a purchase, which is likely to cause noise disturbance in a residential area. Also, the opening hours of 6am to 10pm are extremely unsociable for a residential area.
- 2. There is already a prevalent problem with litter along this stretch of road, and I feel that premises selling alcohol will encourage the occurrences of consuming food/drink and then throwing rubbish onto the street.
- 3. There is no parking outside the property so owners of vehicles will be tempted to pull up along the kerbside (double yellow lines) to 'pop in', potentially blocking access to my property and other neighbour's driveways.
- 4. There is also a low wall between our two properties which I (and the tenants) would not like to see customers using as a seating area whilst they consume their purchases.
