

Performance Report – February 2016

Recorded crime figures are based on the current Home Office Crime Groupings. From April 2014, crime is classified by the Home Office as either Victim Based or Crimes against society

Victim Based - Violence with injury, violence without injury, sexual offences, business robbery, personal robbery, domestic burglary, non-domestic burglary, theft of vehicle, theft from vehicle, interfere with vehicle, bicycle theft, shoplifting, all other theft offences and criminal damage and arson.

Crimes against society - Drug offences, possession of weapons offences, public order offences and miscellaneous crimes against society.

As of 2013, the majority of Fraud offences are recorded nationally by Action Fraud. Those recorded by the police are mainly 'making off without payment' offences which are now recorded under 'other stealing'. Therefore, 'Fraud and Forgery' offences are excluded from this report.

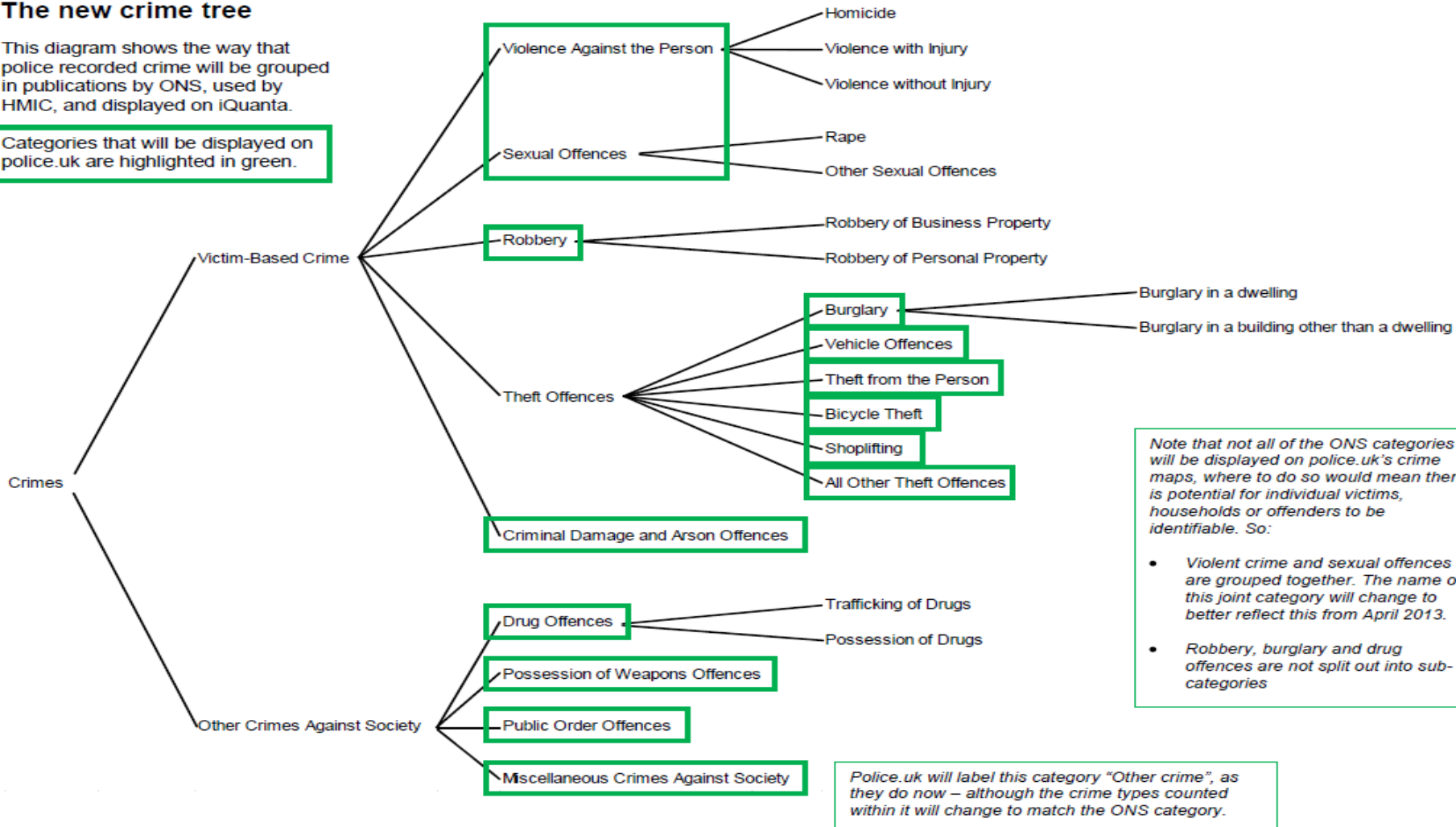
Crime and Incident Data are based on the recorded date of the crime / incident and reflects the data as at the point the data is taken from live Guardian and Command and Control systems. It is therefore subject to change.

Data is provided for the Administrative County and each Council Area for Derbyshire (including Derby City). Comparisons are made for the latest full 12 month periods with the previous 12 months. Year to date / historical levels will be mentioned where appropriate with specific figures provided (Full Year to Date and previous monthly figure data tables are available on request). A green highlight indicates a reduction in crime/ incidents, with a red highlight

The new crime tree

This diagram shows the way that police recorded crime will be grouped in publications by ONS, used by HMIC, and displayed on iQuanta.

Categories that will be displayed on police.uk are highlighted in green.



Note that not all of the ONS categories will be displayed on police.uk's crime maps, where to do so would mean there is potential for individual victims, households or offenders to be identifiable. So:

- Violent crime and sexual offences are grouped together. The name of this joint category will change to better reflect this from April 2013.
- Robbery, burglary and drug offences are not split out into sub-categories

Police.uk will label this category "Other crime", as they do now – although the crime types counted within it will change to match the ONS category.

Comment.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in the Admin County has seen a 3.2% increase when compared with the previous 12 months (+1001). The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+765), Violence without injury (+625), Sexual offences (+281) and Theft from vehicle (+183). The largest decreases are in Other theft (-545), Shoplifting (-352), Non domestic burglary (-187) and Drug offences (-179).

February 2016 – All crime (2711) is below the past 12 months average (2720). Shoplifting (277) was the highest count since June 2015. All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (+973) has increased by 3.4%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+770), Violence without injury (+546) and Sexual offences (+218). The largest decreases are in Other theft (-496), Shoplifting (-307), Drug offences (-183) and Non domestic burglary (-124).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 3.6% reduction (-1064) when compared with the previous 12 months. Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 1005 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

Comment.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in Amber Valley has seen 4.8% increase when compared with the previous 12 months (+247).

The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+181), Violence without injury (+125), Sexual offences (+59) and Criminal damage (+33).

The largest decreases are in Other theft (-107), Non domestic burglary (-65), and Shoplifting (-36).

February 2016 – All crime (465) is above the past 12 months average (452). Theft from vehicle (50) and Shoplifting (67) both had their highest counts in the past 2 years. Domestic burglary (14) had the lowest count in the past 2 years. All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (+228) has increased by 4.8%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+198), Violence without injury (+102) and Sexual offences (+51). The largest decreases are in Other theft (-112) and Non domestic burglary (-57).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 1.8% decrease (-88) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 85 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

Comment.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in Bolsover has seen a 10.2% increase when compared with the previous 12 months (+344).

The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+107), Theft from vehicle (+72) and Violence without injury (+60).

The largest decreases are in Domestic burglary (-32) and Non domestic burglary (-22).

February 2016 – All crime (286) is below the past 12 months average (309). Violence without injury (15) and Non domestic burglary (13) both had their lowest counts in the past 2 years. All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (+335) has increased by 11%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+103), Theft from vehicle (+79) and Violence without injury (+51). The largest decreases are in Domestic burglary (-25) and Non domestic burglary (-22).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 6.3% decrease (-219) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 207 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in Chesterfield has seen a 1% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months (-60).

The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+122), Non domestic burglary (+80) and Violence without injury (+73).

The largest decreases are in Shoplifting (-198), Other theft (-104) and Theft from vehicle (-68).

February 2016 – All crime (469) is below the past 12 months average (491). Domestic burglary (36) was above the past 12 months average (26). Theft from vehicle (10) was the lowest count in the past 2 years. All remaining crime types were close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (-11) has decreased by 0.2%. The largest increases are in Violence with injury (+128), Non domestic burglary (+77) and Violence without injury (+67). The largest decreases are in Shoplifting (-167), Other theft (-91) and Theft from vehicle (-72).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 3.2% reduction (-182) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 168 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in Derbyshire Dales has seen a 2.1% increase when compared with the previous 12 months (+43).

The largest increases are in Theft from vehicle (+40), Violence with injury (+36) and Sexual offences (+24).

The largest decreases are in Drug offences (-84) and Shoplifting (-30).

February 2016 – All crime (190) is above the past 12 months average (176). Violence without injury (22) has been above the past 12 months average (16) for the last 2 months. Non domestic burglary (13) was the lowest count since March 2015. All remaining crime types are close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (+40) has increased by 2.1%. The largest increases are in Theft from vehicle (+41) and Violence with injury (+32). The largest decreases are in Drug offences (-76) and Shoplifting (-32).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 12.2% reduction (-187) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 185 fewer calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.

Comment.

Rolling 12 months figures - Crime in Erewash has seen a 2.3% reduction when compared with the previous 12 months (-136).

The largest increases are in Violence without injury (+151) and Criminal damage (+66).

The largest decreases are in Non domestic burglary (-131), Other theft (-123) and Shoplifting (-85).

February 2016 – All crime (467) is below the past 12 months average (477). Non Domestic burglary (45) was above the past 12 months average (32). Other theft (56) was also above the past 12 months average (46). All remaining crime types are close to their past 12 months average.

Year to Date figures – Compares April to February 2014/15 and 2015/16. All crime (-155) has decreased by 2.9% The largest increases are in Violence without injury (+135) and Criminal damage (48). The largest decreases are in Other theft (-120), Non domestic burglary (-107) and Shoplifting (-77).

ASB (see Appendix 1) - Calls for Service have seen a 0.3% increase (+15) when compared with the previous 12 months.

Year to date (April 2015 to February 2016) there have been 16 more calls for service than in the corresponding period last year.
