 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company no. 9346363) has made an Order on the A38 Trunk Road, between Ripley and South Normanton, in the County of Derbyshire, to allow street lighting repairs and routine maintenance works to be carried out.

- The effect of the Order will be to –
- (1) impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on –
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 500 metres southwest of the centrepoint of the roundabout junction of the A610 and Hartshay Hill, at Ripley (Hartshay Roundabout), to its roundabout junction with Mansfield Road and the slip roads leading to and from the M1, at Junction 28 (M1 Junction 28 Roundabout);
 - (b) the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with M1 Junction 28 Roundabout, to a point 300 metres southwest of Hartshay Roundabout;
 - (c) the circulatory carriageway of M1 Junction 28 Roundabout; and
 - (d) any slip road leading to or from the lengths of A38 described in (a) and (b) above; and
 - (2) close –
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A38 between its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction of the A61 and B6179 (Watchorn Interchange), and its junction with the slip road leading from that roundabout junction;
 - (b) the slip roads leading –
 - (i) to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from Hartshay Roundabout;
 - (ii) to or from the southbound carriageway of the A38, to or from Hartshay Roundabout;
 - (iii) to or from the A38, to or from Watchorn Interchange;
 - (iv) to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from the B600, at Somercotes; and
 - (v) from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to the B600, at Somercotes; and
 - (c) any layby adjacent to the lengths of A38 described in (1)(a) and (b) above

The work is expected to start on Monday 10 October 2016 and continue for sixteen weeks. The speed restriction and layby closures will be in operation from 08:00 hours on 10 October 2016 for the duration of the works. The closures will be in operation overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours. The Order will come into force on 3 October 2016.

Vehicles being used by the emergency services will be exempt from the speed restriction and closures. Vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via alternative junctions of the A38 will be signed.
