The drinking of alcohol from 10am until 12 midnight will result in people coming down the lane singing and making a lot of noise house windows will get smashes and car windows will get smashed causing damage and fear for ones safety
Cannot understand why they cant leave things as they are. Just for football if this is passed they got planing permission on false pretences
