Public Safety



The entrance to the site is from Newood Back Lane, accessed via Newbold Road & adjacent to the Eraffic light controlled junction with Loundsteap Green Road. This can be a basy junction at most times of the day and can be particularly hazardous at weekends with reductes trijing to access or enter the Brampton Rosers site before and after matches. Loundstey Green Road is also an afterial route for the ambulance service leaving their depot on Old Road, the sound of their warning sirens being a regular occurrence. It consider that the intensification in use of the site access, particularly when rehicles are leaving the premises following an event, would result in a reduction in highways a public safety at this basy junction, contrary to the licensing objectives.



The application site, previously the sports grounds associated with the former Newbold Community School, we is now used by numerous football teams under the banner of Brangton Rovers. Whereas previous noise disturbance caused by sporting activities were limited to school times, the current permitted use of the site results in public disturbance at the weekends, every Saturday & every Sunday, weather allowing. This change to weekend activities on site was permitted without any public consultation since it the proposed use of the sports parition as a centre for public entertainment would constitute centre for partie enter rainment would constitute a major change. The nobe leads currently experienced as a result of the existing football activities, although intrusive, are predominently limited to mornings a afternoons. The proposal to license the premises for a variety of entertainment uses a sale of a kohol for 365 days a year from 8.00 am until midnight would have a significant \$.00 am until midnight would have a significant of all heighbouring residents. If the intention is to hold occasional brithday parties a sports evenings as suggested, then surely an application for a Temporary Event Notice, as required, would enable these events to take place. We consider that the licence now proposed would create an unnecessary, anwanted a inappropriate nightspot in the widde of a guiet residential area, contrary to the licensing objectives.
