1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to request an adjournment of the Licensing Committee hearing in respect of the Review of the premises licence of Pizza Royal, 1 Holywell Street, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S41 7SA.

2.0 APPLICATION

2.1 The application for a review was submitted by Sgt 3402 Winterbottom of Derbyshire Police, on the 13 November 2019.

2.2 The application for review is in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety licensing objectives.

3.0 **BACKGROUND**

3.1 Following a Review of the premise license of Pizza Royal, 1 Holywell Street, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S41 7SA being requested the Police have returned to the premises as a new CCTV system has been installed.

3.2 On 03.01.2020 PC Hussain went to Pizza Royal and found that a new CCTV system had been installed. However, due to its recent installation, only 8 days of footage had been recorded to date and he could not verify whether the new system can accommodate the full 28 day period of images.

4.0 **RECOMMENDATION**

4.1 That the Licensing Committee adjourn this review to allow 28 days to pass so the Police are able to check the CCTV system again, confirming that it now complies with the premises license condition.
