OBJECTION to Premises Licence Variation – The Spotted Frog

Dear Mr Ashby,

I am concerned to hear of the application to vary the licence of the Spotted Frog on Chatsworth Rd, Chesterfield. The addition of an outside bar and entertainment with alcohol sales could be of detriment to the vulnerable people that Eden Futures will be supporting in an assisted living service which is adjacent to the area and currently under development.

The people we will be supporting will have learning disabilities and autism and require roundthe-clock care and support. The impact of increased noise and possible anti-social behaviour as a result of this proposal could have a detrimental impact on their safety and well-being and I would urge you to deny this application in their best interests.
