The tree is located to the rear of Orwins Close, Newbold and has dieback of the crown.	Consent is granted to the crown reduction by 4 metres and the removal of dead wood.
CHE/21/00384/TPO TPO 4901.14 22/06/21	The pruning of one Cedar tree reference T49 on the Order map for Derbyshire County Council. The tree is located in the grass verge to the frontage of 40/42 Netherleigh Road.	Consent is granted to the crown lifting of the trees over the highway, crown thinning to reduce the end weight on the extended branches, the reduction of two protruding branches by a maximum of 2 metres in line with the rest of the crown and to crown clean to remove dead wood.
CHE/21/00336/TPO TPO 4901.60 24/06/21	The felling of one Sycamore tree reference T45 on the Order map for Environmental Services, Leicester at land adjacent to 120 The Green, Hasland. The tree is located in the grassed area and is under the ownership of Chesterfield Borough Council.	Consent is refused to the felling of one Sycamore tree because the information submitted with the application does not conclusively conclude that the tree is the cause of the alleged subsidence damage and other possible causes should be investigated.

It has been reported to DCC that the tree has allegedly dropped a dead branch onto the public footpath.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to remove dead wood within the trees crown.</p>
<p>CHE/21/00487/TPOEXP</p> <p>TPO 4901.201</p> <p>24/06/21</p>	<p>The felling of one Beech tree reference T34 on the Order map for Derbyshire County Council at Goyt Side, Brampton to the frontage of Sonoco Consumer Products. The tree is suffering from severe dieback of the crown.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the felling of one Beech tree which is nearly dead with no possibility of recovering. The duty to plant a replacement tree has been dispensed with on this occasion due to the small planting area and no other alternative location. Other trees along the highway also contribute to the amenity of the area.</p>
<p>CHE/21/00441/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.43</p> <p>24/06/21</p>	<p>The felling of 5 Larch trees within G20 on the Order map and the removal of dead wood on the remaining trees on the site for Mark Whatley Tree Services on behalf of Mr David Lyons of 19a Somersall Lane Somersall.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the removal of 5 Larch trees which show evidence of root plate movement due to the wet ground. A condition is attached to plant one specimen tree of either a Weeping Willow or Grey Alder planted in the centre of the lawn as a focal point to the garden.</p> <p>Consent is also granted to the removal of dead wood to all the remaining trees in the grounds of the property.</p>

<p>CHE/21/00459/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.112</p> <p>25/06/21</p>	<p>The pruning of one Oak tree reference T4 on the Order map for Gary McCarthy on behalf of Chesterfield Borough Council to the frontage of 136 Kirkstone Road, Dunston.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the crown reduction by 3 metres of one Oak tree and the removal of dead wood.</p>
<p>CHE/21/00415/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.37</p> <p>25/06/21</p>	<p>The felling of one Cherry and one Sycamore within G2 on the Order map for Idverde on behalf of Guinness Partnership at Eyre Gardens. The trees have outgrown their situation and the Cherry is dropping large amounts of dead wood.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the felling of two trees with a condition to plant two Rowan trees which are more suited to the location.</p>
<p>CHE/21/00088/TPO</p> <p>TPO 4901.43</p> <p>29/06/21</p>	<p>The felling of one Sweet Gum tree reference T88 and the pruning of two Beech trees reference T104 &amp; T105 on the Order map for Mr Watmore of 4 Somersall Willows, Somersall.</p>	<p>Consent is granted to the felling of one Sweet Gum tree reference T88 which is causing damage to the tarmac surfacing and has clearly outgrowing its location and small planting pit. The duty to plant a replacement tree has been dispensed with on this occasion due to other trees on the property and no loss of amenity.</p> <p>Consent is also granted to the heavy crown reduction of two Beech trees. The reduction of the two trees by 50% is to be carried out over two years to reduce the impact on the trees and which would reduce the possibility of T104 failing on the main stem which in</p>

		turn requires the adjacent Beech T105 to be reduced to avoid the sudden exposure to the elements once the adjacent tree has been reduced in height. The tree works are to retain the mature trees rather than felling which was originally proposed.
CHE/21/00/TPO TPO 4901.153 29/06/21	The pruning of trees within G3 & G4 on the Order map for Gary McCarthy on behalf of Chesterfield Borough Council at Water Lane, Loundsley ground to allow free passage along the public footpath.	Consent is granted to the crown lifting by 2.5 metres and the cutting back of side branches to clear the public footpath.
